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## Introduction

Book Systems, Inc. provides the **Atrium on the Go™** application for iPhone®, iPad®, and Android™ devices. Librarians or patrons can use the app to access the library catalog and search for items (by ISBN or barcode). Once connected to **Mobile OPAC**, you can reserve or renew titles, read reviews, view **What's Hot** items, log on to **My Items**, and more based on settings and permissions. Librarians can refer to Atrium Help or the **OPAC Handbook**, available from the **Downloads** form, for more details about configuration.

This document lists the requirements for your mobile device to work correctly with **Atrium on the Go** and provides steps for installing and using the app. Images in this document are examples; what you see will vary depending on your device.

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## Atrium on the Go for iPhone and iPad

Review the following requirements to see if your device is compatible:

- iPhone version 4 or higher
- iPad version 2 or higher
- Most current version of Atrium
- Internet connection

Open the **App Store™** on your device, and search for **Atrium on the Go**.



Tap the app from the results to open a page with images, install options, overview information, requirements, etc. Tap **GET** and then **INSTALL**.



You will be prompted to sign in to your **iTunes Store®** account (which must have associated credit card information even though this particular app is free). An icon  displays while the app is downloaded and installed to your device. When it is finished, tap **OPEN**.

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## Atrium on the Go for Android

Review the following requirements to see if your device is compatible:

- Android version 2.1 or higher
- Most current version of Atrium
- Internet connection
- Built-in camera or scanner with auto-focus (required to scan ISBN or barcode)

Open the **Google Play™** store app. Search for **Atrium on the Go**, and then tap the app from the results to view a page with images from the app, install options, overview information, requirements, etc.




Tap **INSTALL**. You may be prompted to give the app permission to access certain areas of your device; tap **ACCEPT**. You will see a **Downloading...** and **Installing...** message; when the process is finished, tap **OPEN**.

## Atrium on the Go Settings

The image to the right illustrates the first screen you see when you open the app. To configure settings manually, enter text in the following fields; some information you need displays in your Atrium URL (pictured below).

- **Server:** — Enter the main DNS or IP address for your Atrium. This is the first part of the address between the double slashes and the first single slash (highlighted in yellow in the image above).
- **Port:** — Enter or change the number as needed; depending on your device and connection type, you may see 80 or 443 (SSL).
- **Library:** — Enter the prefix for your library URL. This is the part of the address after “/opac/” (highlighted in blue in the image above).
- **Pre-check connection:** — This setting may or may not be enabled based on your device; if it is disabled, you should tap to enable this so the app checks to be sure your settings work correctly. An alert displays if they do not.
- **Use SSL:** (Android only) — This setting is disabled by default. If your server is set up to use a secure connection, you must enable this by tapping the option. iPhone or iPad users should simply enter “**https://**” in the **Server:** field.



To configure settings automatically, librarians can generate a QR Code, which is a barcode with an embedded URL that mobile phones can read; then anyone who uses **Atrium on the Go** can scan the code to populate settings fields.

- Locate a QR Code generator. For instance, you could visit <http://beqrious.com/qr-code-generator/>.
- Create a code using the base URL to your **OPAC**, such as the one pictured earlier. In most cases, you can simply select your type (Web URL) and enter the address; you may also be able to designate a color.
- Print the graphic and post it by the circulation desk in your library, or download and embed an electronic version on your library Web site. Patrons can easily enter the app settings by scanning the code.
- While on the **Required Fields** screen, tap **Scan QR Code for Settings** and then scan the code to automatically insert data.


## Atrium on the Go

### Atrium on the Go Features

Once you have settings configured for the app on your device, you can use either of the following options when you open **Atrium on the Go**: **Connect to Library** or **Scan ISBN or Barcode**.

You can tap the **Connect to Library** option at any time to open **Mobile OPAC** (pictured to the right). From here, you can search the catalog by entering terms in the field at the top, or you can access other features by tapping the icons.

You can tap **Scan ISBN or Barcode** to connect to the camera or scanner on your device, scan an ISBN or holdings barcode, and search your library catalog for a match. For example, you can scan an ISBN on an item in a local bookstore to see if your library has a copy, or you can scan a holdings barcode on a library item to find more details, reviews, etc. saved in the catalog.
