### T-Ball Rules

1. Games will be three (3) innings, or 60 minutes.
2. Every child will bat in all innings.
3. Twelve (12) players will play defense (6 outfielders) per inning. Every child must play at least one (1) inning in the field.
4. Batter has the option of using tee or underhand pitch from coach. Tee must be used if batter has not hit a fair ball after two (2) strikes.
5. Batter has a maximum of two (2) strikes or five (5) pitches before using tee. No batter will “strike out.”
6. No score will be kept.
7. Base runners called “out” will not be allowed to remain on base.
8. Home team is listed last on schedule (home bats last).

## Playing Rules

1. Games will be 5 innings, or 75 minutes.
2. An inning is when 3 outs are made or if all players have batted. An equal number of players must bat for each team.
3. Ten (10) defensive players will play each inning (coaches will pitch and catch with a helper beside them for when ball is in play).
4. Batter has 3 strikes to hit a fair ball, or a maximum of 5 pitches. If the batter hits a foul ball on 3<sup>rd</sup> strike, they will receive another pitch.
5. Score will be kept. Standings will be posted on bulletin board by concession stand.
6. One adult volunteer umpire is needed per game.
7. Helmets are required for batter and base runners (not provided by Parks Department).
8. Ball is dead when inside pitcher circle. Runners must return to previous base if not at least half way to next base.
9. Home team is listed last on schedule (home bats last, even if winning).
